OBJECTIVES :



- Training of the students for scientific research, for the university teaching career and further training of doctors in the dental health network;

- Ensuring a high level of documentation and preparation of students to enable and facilitate the entry into the doctoral studies;

- Deepening of a topic in oral rehabilitation of edentulous and loss of oro-maxillo-facial substance, which is characterized by new, high incidence of pathology in the Romanian population, new treatment regimens that require continuous improvement;



- Multidisciplinary approach to these highly topical themes, with direct practical applicability and impact, particularly for development and progress of modern dentistry, these patients remain isolated due to mutilation;

- Improvement of the support services in dentistry given to the population by increasing the professional level of young generation.



Implanto-prosthetic Rehabilitation of Edentulous

DURATION: 2 years

The program duration is 4 semesters, 48 weeks, interspersed with 16 weeks of holiday per year (4 weeks in winter, 4 weeks in spring, 8 weeks in summer) - 60 credits.

The program will include courses, clinical internships, demonstrations, seminars, clinical presentations, conferences, which will make a total of 11 hours per week, from which 6 course hours and 5 laboratories hours and 3 hours per week to prepare for dissertation paper .

For this master can apply all Bachelors of a Dental Medicine Faculty. The courses, practical demonstrations, clinical stages will take place at the Faculty of Dental Medicine, UMF „Gr.T. Popa” Iași.

DOCUMENTS NECESSARY FOR ADMITTANCE:

Registration for admittance examination : **between September 15th - October 1st.**



The registration file must contain:

- Baccalaureate diploma - legalized copy,
- License diploma - legalized copy / certificate of accreditation of the licensing exam promotion indicating the average college graduation and average at the license exam.
- Record of service /supplement - legalized copy,
- Birth certificate - legalized copy,
- Marriage certificate - legalized copy,
- Option for the chosen specialization field,
- The foreign language chosen for exam.

The documents written in other languages than English or French must be translated in Romanian or English.

The Diplomas from Italy, Greece, Spain, Portugal and Cyprus must be checked with Hague Apostille.

The Diplomas emitted from countries which do not belong to the Convention regarding the Hague Apostille must be legalized by the External Affairs Ministry of the original country and by its Embassy / Consular Office.

DOCUMENTS NECESSARY FOR ADMITTANCE:

The admittance to the postgraduate program consists, according to the Education Law, in a competition organized yearly, between **October 1st and 3rd**, which contains :

- Psychological test ,
 - Interview,
 - Foreign language exam ,
 - Skills in computer using
- (ELIMINATING TESTS).

The candidates will be admitted in **descending order of average**, calculated as follows: **75% of the faculty multi-annual average and 25% of the license exam average**.

The final average will be the arithmetic average of the college graduation average, the average of the graduation exam and of the masters exam.

The candidates must demonstrate that they have communication skills, teamwork, analytical and synthetic thinking and proper moral conduct.



DIPLOMA AND RECOGNITION:

The graduates of the Postgraduate Program Master are receiving a **POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA** or **MASTER** and a **MASTER CERTIFICATE**, according to the law.

COMPETENCES OBTAINED AT THE END OF THE PROGRAM:

The Master's graduate in oral rehabilitation of edentulous and loss of oro-maxillo-facial substance at the end of four semesters of studies will be able to develop a comprehensive treatment plan, anchored in solving toothless by implanto-prosthetic therapy, the various types of losses the substance in the oral-maxillo-facial territory will be resolved by developing epithesis and maxillo-facial prostheses, aspect that involves a high degree of complexity.

During the four semesters of theoretical and practical studies, the graduate masters will gain the ability of discernment and selection of the large knowledge in the field that can absorb at a theoretical level and then applied on a practical level.

FREQUENCY: each semester .

MODULE 'Basic Theory 2'

AIM: Independent planning of simple prosthetic implant therapies on host bone and independent surgical and prosthetic work on the patient simulator .
FREQUENCY: each semester .

MODULE 'Placement'

AIM: The independent written and literature-based analysis of planned therapies and the demonstrated treatment stages .
FREQUENCY: each semester .

MODULE 'Supervision'

AIM: The independent performance of surgical procedures and prosthetic treatments on patients and the development of critical, reflective, professional competence .
FREQUENCY: each semester .

MODULE 'Patient Treatment'

AIM: The independent performance of surgical procedures and prosthetic treatments on the patient and the development of critical, reflective, professional competence .
FREQUENCY: each semester .

MODULE 'Surgical Techniques'

AIM: Independent planning of complex prosthetic implant therapies and independent surgical procedures on patients .
FREQUENCY: each semester .

MODULE 'Implant prosthetics'

AIM: Independent planning of complex prosthetic implant therapies and independent prosthetic implants on patients .
FREQUENCY: each semester .

MODULE 'Dissertation Master'

AIM: Demonstrates that the student is in a position to independently analyze and assess a topic within the field of oral implantology within a prescribed period using scientifically recognized methods .
FREQUENCY: each semester .

KNOWLEDGE ASSESSMENT :

- During the program of study, laboratories and seminars,
- At the end of each module by written examination and colloquium for practice (portfolio of the solved cases)
- At the end of the masters program through the presentation of a dissertation (in October).
